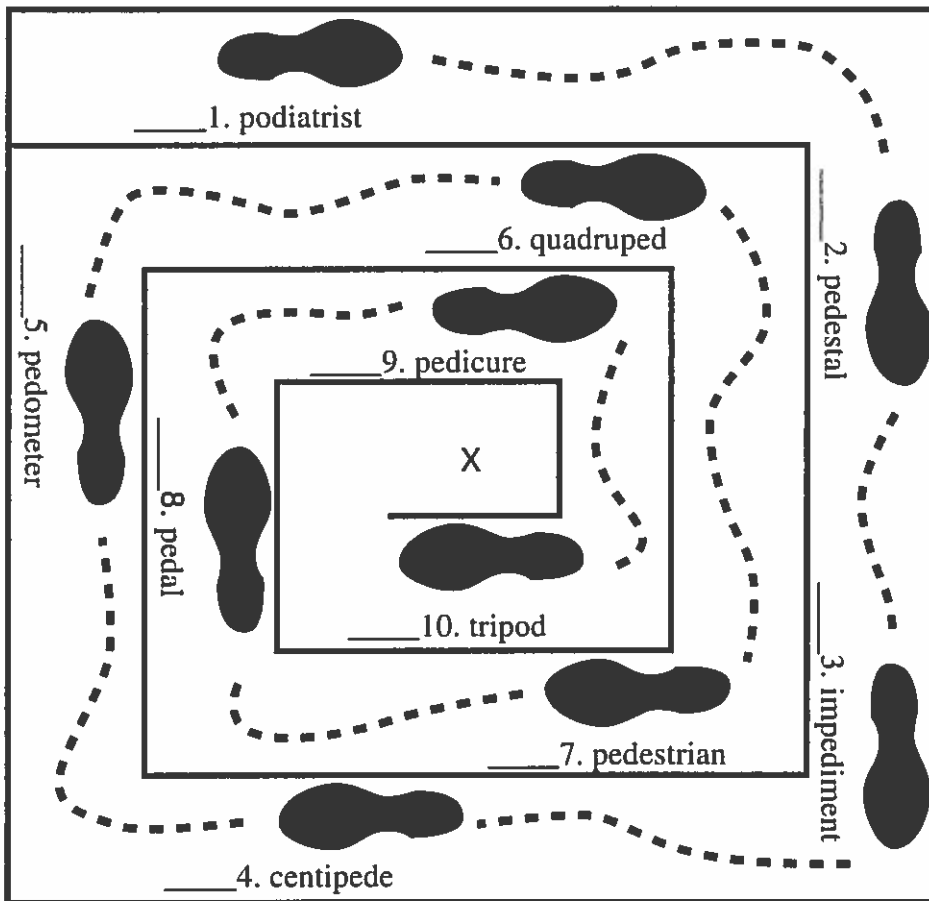


# Fancy Footwork

- j. an obstacle to one's feet; a hindrance

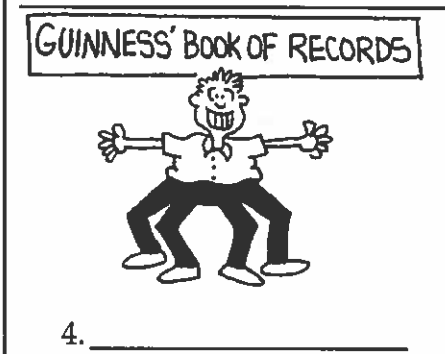
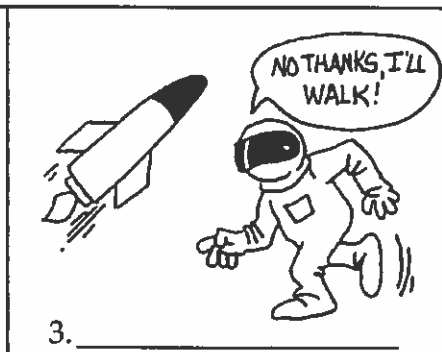


Cut along the bold lines. Attach a length of string at the center X. Hang your fancy footwork where you can review the words frequently.

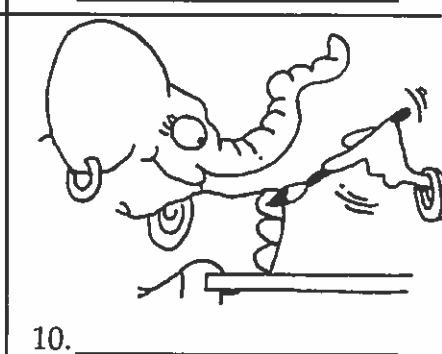
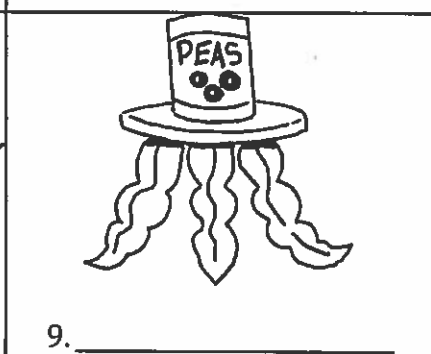
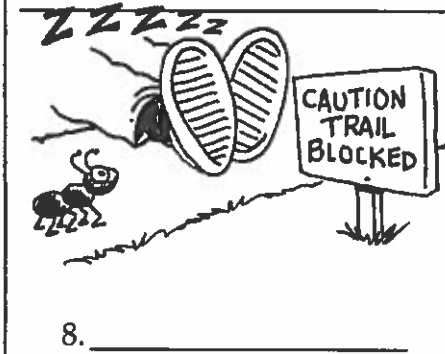
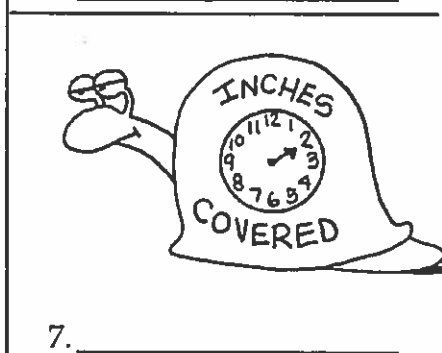
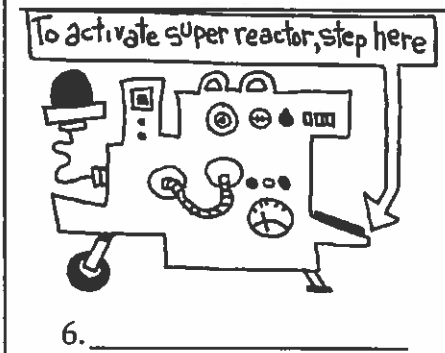


# Feet First
